COURTHOUSE GUIDE

Williamson County, Texas



WHERE:

The courthouse complex for Williamson County is called the Williamson County Justice Center. The Justice Center is located in Georgetown Texas at 405 Martin Luther King Street, Georgetown, TX 78626. The Justice Center is open from 8 am to 5pm.

TYPES OF CASES HEARD:

The Williamson County Justice Center holds all Misdemeanor and District Courts for Williamson County.

PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION TIPS:

There are plenty of free parking options at the Courthouse. There is a public lot directly across the street from the Justice Center and a free parking garage next to the parking lot, in front of the Williamson County Jail.

SECURITY PROCEDURES:

All individuals entering the Justice Center are required to go through a security screening. All bags will be searched.

INSIDE LAYOUT:

The Justice Center houses all county offices that are involved in criminal matters. As you enter the building, there is a help desk that can assist with general questions and computer monitors that list the dockets for the day.

If you are on a Pre-trial contract or are checking in with probation, you will find the main office located next to the help desk. The Williamson County Pre-Trial Department and Williamson County Probation Department are located as you enter the building. Oftentimes, those on pre-trial or with motions to revoke probation will be required to check in with officials ahead of court. It is important that you check in as directed to either Pre-Trial or Probation.

The Williamson County District Clerk's Office, which handles all felony documentation, is located on the first floor.

IN WILLIAMSON COUNTY, ALL FELONY CASES ARE HANDLED BY THREE COURTS:

The 277th Judicial District Court, the 368th Judicial District Court and the 26th Judicial District Court. All three courts are located on the first floor of the Justice Center.

The Williamson County District Attorney's Office is responsible for prosecuting all felony matters for the county. Their office is located on the second floor.

IN WILLIAMSON COUNTY, ALL MISDEMEANOR CASES ARE HANDLED BY THREE COUNTY COURTS:

The County Court at Law 2, the County Court at Law 3 and the County Court at Law 5. All three courts are located on the second floor of the Justice Center.

The County Clerk, where you can obtain misdemeanor documentation, is located on the second floor.

The Williamson County Attorney's Office is responsible for prosecuting all misdemeanor matters for the county. Their office is located on the second floor.

COURTROOM ETIQUETTE:

Courtrooms are strictly monitored by the Williamson County Sheriff's Department. It is important that you are dressed appropriately to attend your court appearance. You could be barred from entering the courtroom or must leave to change clothing. For example, shorts, flip flops and t-shirts are prohibited. A full list of prohibited clothing can be found at wilcotx.gov. Respectable behavior is required in court at all times. Cell phones must be turned off or placed on silent. If your cell phone goes off in court, it can be confiscated until the end of the day.
